Central Electric Cooperative (CEC) is proud to offer its Fourth Annual Good Neighbor Scholarship program. Applicants must be able to communicate how they contributed non-paid time to help their community, school and church. The program awards scholarships to CEC members or to their children.

Applicants must be enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution, complete our application, provide a letter of reference and write a one-page essay on how they have contributed to being a good neighbor in their community.

The deadline for applications and supporting documents is **March 15th** of each year.

Application Guidelines

Applicant must receive electric service from CEC and their account must be in good standing. This is a one-time award per individual.

Applicants must provide the following to qualify:

- A completed Good Neighbor Scholarship application. The application can be found at www.central.coop under the Community tab
- A copy of an acceptance letter from a post-secondary educational institution
- A letter of recommendation from a high school, employer or organization
- A one-page typed essay describing activities accomplished by applicant highlighting their commitment to the community, school and church
